ABSTRACT

myDEQ provides an online portal for Arizonans to obtain, modify, terminate and submit compliance reports to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality. The portal helps grow Arizona businesses by speeding up permitting processes from several days/weeks to real-time e-permitting, thus reducing and, in some cases, eliminating the burden of paper permitting and compliance reporting on the regulated community.

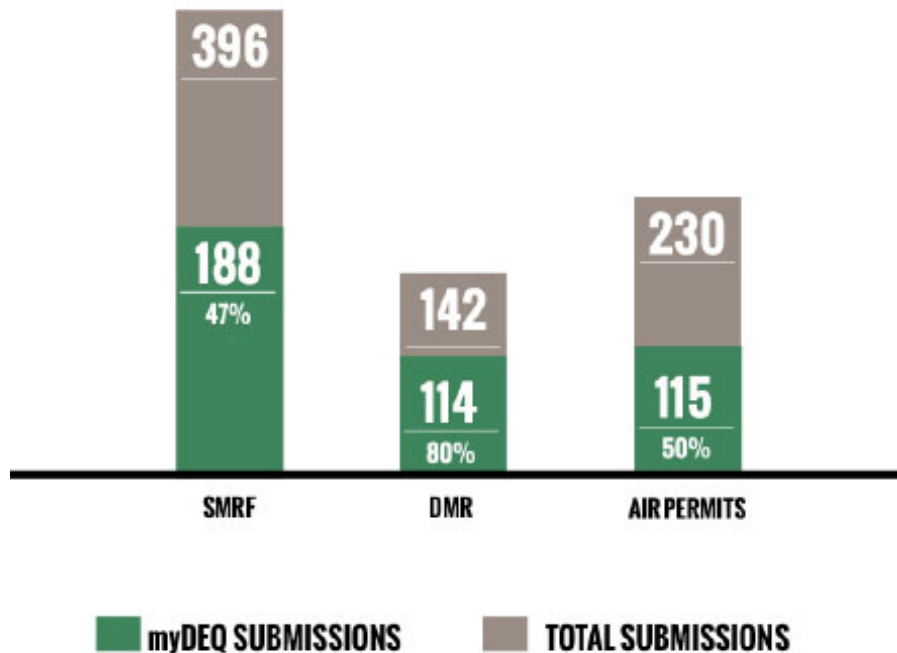

Air Permits at the speed of Arizona's Businesses

In June 2016, AZ DEQ launched the first 100% paperless permit for the agency in myDEQ, with over 50% customer adoption rate within the first 9 months. On April 23rd, 2017 the renewal module was released with over 18% customers renewing in the first week.
