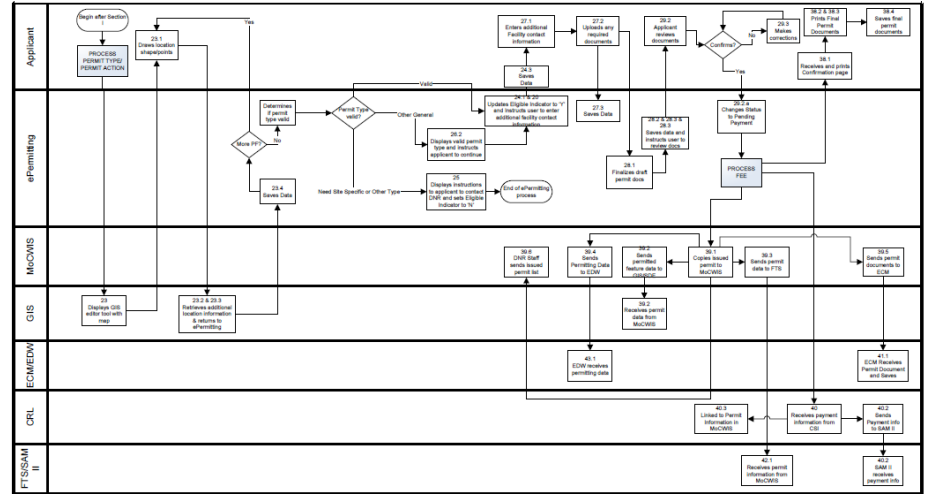
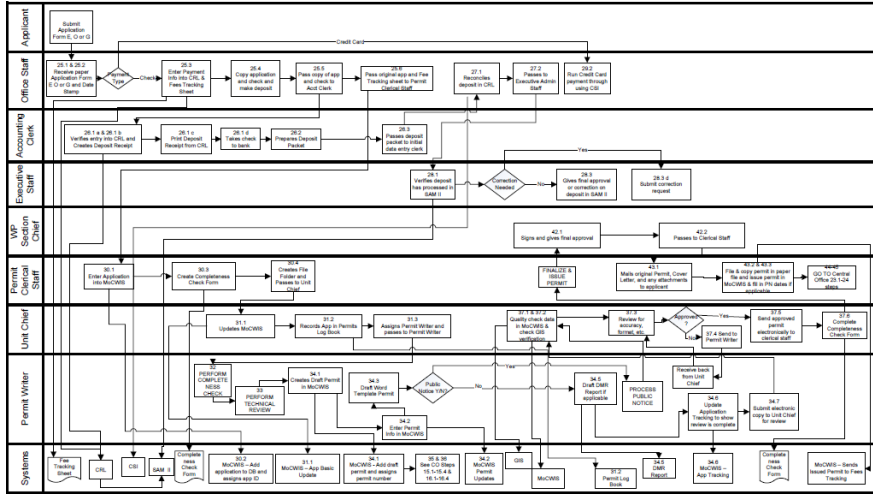


# IT Governance to E3: Example 1

- **Major Regulatory Program/Function**
  - 9 separate databases (8 access, 1 SQL)
  - Misc. Excel spreadsheets
  - IT request to “consolidate into an efficient, stable database with web-based data entry”
  - No documented business processes (as-is or future)
  - Referred to E3 for business process re-engineering



# Previous Process Mapping



**Reduced # of Steps by 53%**  
**Reduced Elapsed Time from 2 weeks to < 1 hour**

# E3 to IT Governance: Example 2

- **Grant/Loan Workflow & Tracking**
  - Legacy technology dictates business process
  - Need new IT tool/application
  - Kaizen Event (Jan. 2016)
  - New IT tool/application from improved business process



# Summary

- **Key Points**

- IT Governance & E3 work together, but both are stand-alone
- Not all IT Projects Need E3

- Potential Large influx of projects from IT to E3
- E3 Capacity
